10-Year Plan Community Champions are one of the key innovative technologies that have emerged from the National Partnership being constellated by the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness. From the early adopters including San Francisco's Mayor Gavin Newsom who appointed civic leader and former Supervisor Angela Alioto to develop and lead the city's 10-Year Plan and Atlanta Mayor Shirley Franklin who asked retired attorney and businessman Horace Sibley to develop and implement Atlanta's regional Blueprint, many cities of all sizes now follow the best practice of engaging prominent business and civic leaders to move 10-Year Plan partners and investments to results in the community.
